ACE to Participate in Conference in European Parliament

Brussels - On Wednesday 5th of March 2008 the Assyria Council of Europe as represented by Mr. Ninos Warda will participate in a conference in the European Parliament in Brussels on the issue of persecuted Christian minorities. The conference is being organized by the Alliance of Liberals and Democrats for Europe and will begin at 15.00 o'clock.

Mr. Warda will speak on behalf of ACE with regards to the plight of the Assyrians in Iraq following the fall of Saddam Hussein's regime, and what must be done by the international community to protect this indigenous people from extinction in their homeland.
