

Assyrian Lobbyist Appointed in Brussels

Brussels (AINA) -- Netherlands-based [Assyria Foundation](#) has appointed Mr. Ninos Warda to the chief lobbyist position in Brussels. The lobbying project is modelled after the Washington-based [Iraq Sustainable Democracy Project](#) (ISDP), which has been in operation since April 2005 and lobbies for Assyrian rights in Iraq. Mr. Warda will lobby the EU on behalf of Assyrians in the Middle East.

According to Ms. Attiya Gamri, an Assyrian Dutch politician, "the Assyrians in the EU support this project and are prepared to give it the efforts it requires."

Mr. Ninos Warda, an Assyrian born in London, England, whose parents were both born in Iraq, will work full-time for this project. He holds a Bachelor of Laws (LLB) degree. He is currently studying for his Master of Laws (LLM) degree in the field of International Law at the University of London.
